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#### INTRODUCTION

With the motto "Vidya Dadaati Vinayam"- knowledge gives politeness - Govt. College Bhoranj (Tarkwari) Distt. Hamirpur was established in the year 2002. Since its very inception, it has progressively emerged as one of the reputed institutions of the district.
