








- The Orientation Programme for the first-year students will be organized on **07.07.2025 (Monday) at 11:00 AM** in the **Examination Hall** of the college.

In this meeting the **Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)** of Government College Bhoranj (Tarkwari) decided the following **Quality Initiatives** for the **Session 2025-26**:

A. Academic and Teaching–Learning Initiatives

1. Organization of Orientation Programme for the first year students.
2. A comprehensive Academic Calendar will be prepared and strict adherence to it will be ensured by IQAC.
3. As a quality initiative for the academic session 2025–26, the IQAC has decided to create a special slot in the timetable for regular visits to the Library, Language Lab, and IT Lab to ensure optimum utilization of institutional resources and promote reading habits, language proficiency, and digital literacy.
4. Establishment of a Digital Library to provide seamless access to e-books, journals, research papers, and other online learning resources.
5. To organize at least one National or International Conference.
6. Strengthening of the college library through purchase of additional books, particularly for competitive examinations such as UGC NET and IIT JAM, along with subscription to more magazines and journals.
7. To start more Add-on Courses through HPKVN and at college level.
8. Collaboration with industry and nearby institutions will be encouraged through signing of MoUs.
9. To organize objective-type tests based on General Studies for all students to prepare them for various competitive examinations.

10. From session 2025–26, thematic lectures delivered by invited speakers will be extended from NSS volunteers to all students of the college and telecast live through the College YouTube Channel to ensure wider participation and create a digital repository.

B. Research, Quality Assurance and Institutional Development Initiatives

11. Academic Audit, Gender Audit, Energy Audit and Green Audit for the session 2024–25 will be conducted.
12. IQAC will continuously monitor implementation of quality initiatives and promote outcome-based institutional development.
13. Staff members will be encouraged to write at least one research/review paper and undertake research projects

C. Student Support, Health and Capacity Building Initiatives

14. To organize health check-up programmes for staff and students.
15. In view of increasing natural disasters in Himachal Pradesh, Disaster Management Training will be imparted to students to strengthen preparedness and response capabilities.

18. Green Campus Initiatives will be undertaken by the Campus Development & Beautification Committee, NSS, ECO Club and other departments.











E. Cultural and Sports Development Initiatives

Minutes of IQAC Review Meeting on Academic Learning Outcomes

Date: 25.10.2025

A review meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was held under the chairmanship of the Principal to evaluate the **Academic Learning Outcomes (ALO)** attained by students across all courses during the academic session 2024-25

The IQAC Coordinator presented the outcome assessment proformas based on the established mechanism of measuring learning outcomes on a **Five-Point Scale (1-5)** for all courses offered by the institution. The assessment was carried out using internal assessment performance and annual examination results.

The review revealed varied levels of attainment across different courses:

- Some courses demonstrated **Low Attainment** (below expected benchmark), indicating the need for focused academic intervention and enhanced student support mechanisms.
- Several courses reflected **Moderate Attainment**, showing satisfactory progress but requiring further improvement to achieve desired institutional targets.
- A number of courses achieved **High Attainment**, indicating effective teaching-learning practices and satisfactory student performance.
- Certain courses recorded **Very High Attainment**, reflecting excellent achievement of the intended learning outcomes and successful implementation of academic strategies.











After detailed deliberations, the following decisions were taken:


1. Concerned departments with low attainment levels shall conduct detailed gap analysis and prepare improvement action plans.
2. Remedial classes, mentoring sessions, tutorial support, and outcome-based teaching strategies shall be strengthened for courses with lower attainment.
3. Best practices adopted in courses showing high and very high attainment shall be documented and shared across departments.

4. Continuous monitoring of learning outcomes shall be undertaken through periodic assessment and review.
5. Faculty members shall align teaching methodologies and assessment tools more closely with Course Outcomes (COs) and Programme Outcomes (POs).

All committee members were advised to remain proactive and regularly update the IQAC regarding progress and challenges, if any.











The members actively participated and shared their inputs and suggestions, which were duly noted by the IQAC Coordinator for further action.


Resolutions:

Quality Initiative Review Meeting for Academic Session 2025–26

A review meeting of IQAC was held under the Chairmanship of the Principal to assess the implementation and progress of various quality initiatives undertaken during the academic session 2025–26. The IQAC Coordinator presented the action taken report and the following points were reviewed and resolved:

A. Academic and Teaching–Learning Initiatives

1. The committee reviewed and appreciated the successful organization of the **Orientation Programme for first-year students on 07.07.2025**, which helped students become familiar with institutional facilities, academic procedures, and student support services.
2. It was reported that the **Comprehensive Academic Calendar** for the session 2025–26 had been prepared and circulated among all departments. Departments were directed to continue strict adherence to the academic schedule.
3. IQAC reviewed the success of introducing a **special slot in the timetable for regular visits to the Library, Language Lab and IT Lab**. The initiative was found beneficial in improving utilization of institutional resources and enhancing reading habits, communication skills and digital literacy among students.
4. The committee reviewed the progress regarding the **establishment of the Digital Library** and expressed satisfaction over the steps taken to provide students with access to e-books, journals, research articles and online academic resources.
5. After discussion, it was decided that **one International Conference will be organized in the month of December, 2025**, and the concerned committee was directed to initiate necessary preparations.
6. It was further resolved that the **course content delivered to students in the IT Lab and Language Lab shall be treated as Add-on Courses for the academic session 2025–26**, and appropriate certification and record maintenance mechanisms shall be developed.
7. IQAC reviewed the proposal submitted by **Agastayan Technology, Mohali, Punjab** for signing an **MoU with the institution**. The proposal was discussed in detail and the committee recommended initiating further formal procedures for collaboration in the areas of skill development, training and industry interaction.
8. It was reported that the **Objective-Type General Studies Test** for students was successfully organized on 12.08.2025 and received encouraging participation from students preparing for competitive examinations.
9. The committee reviewed the progress regarding the **setting up of a Virtual Classroom** for live telecast of thematic lectures delivered during the **Seven-Day NSS Special Camp**.

The initiative was appreciated for extending participation and creating a digital academic repository.

B. Research, Quality Assurance and Institutional Development Initiatives

10. It was resolved that the **Academic Audit, Gender Audit, Energy Audit and Green Audit** shall be conducted after completion of the academic session so that a comprehensive assessment of institutional performance may be undertaken.
11. IQAC reaffirmed its commitment towards continuous monitoring of quality initiatives and promoting outcome-based institutional development.
12. Faculty members were encouraged to continue engaging in research activities and publication of research/review papers.

C. Student Support, Health and Capacity Building Initiatives

13. The committee reviewed and appreciated the successful organization of the **Health Check-up Programme** on 01.10.2025 for students and staff.
14. It was decided that a **Blood Donation Camp** shall be organized in the month of **February** in collaboration with concerned health authorities, NSS, NCC, R&R Units and Red Ribbon Club to promote community participation and social responsibility.

15. Extension activities and community outreach programmes through NSS and R&R Units were reviewed and departments were encouraged to continue strengthening institutional social responsibility initiatives.
16. Green campus initiatives undertaken by various committees and clubs were reviewed and appreciated.

E. Cultural and Sports Development Initiatives

17. IQAC, Department of Physical Education and Student Sports Committee reviewed and appreciated the successful organization of **Intramural Badminton and Table Tennis Tournaments**.
18. It was further proposed that an **Intramural Cricket Tournament** shall be organized in the month of **February** to encourage wider student participation in sports activities.










19. The committee reviewed and recorded with satisfaction that the **construction work of the New College Library Building has been completed.**

7. The IQAC Coordinator was requested to monitor progress periodically and provide necessary support to the criterion-wise committees.
8. It was resolved that all concerned committees shall complete the assigned work within the stipulated timeline and submit compliance reports to IQAC.


Resolution:








Overall Outcome
