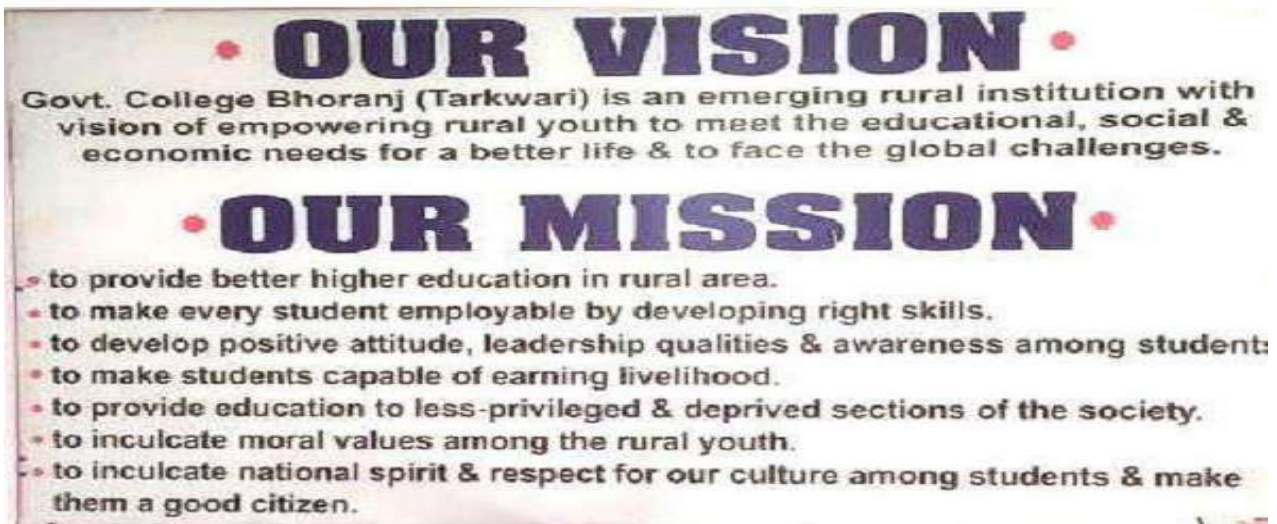

## **Institutional Development Plan: Proposed Under RUSA 2.0 Scheme**

Government College Bhoranj (Tarkwari) has developed an Institutional Development Plan for the fiscal year 2023-24 to utilize the funds allocated from the RUSA 2.0 Infrastructure Grant to Colleges. The college has effectively utilized the first instalment of RUSA 2.0 grant of ₹10000000.00 and second instalment of ₹10000000.00 is expected in this year. The aim of this plan is to enhance the college's infrastructure, facilities, and resources to provide an improved learning environment for students and faculty. This report provides a detailed overview of the projects that will be implemented under the Institutional Development Plan.

### **A. New Construction:**

**Library Building Construction:** Under the new construction category, the college plans to focus on the completion of the library building construction. A balance payment of ₹4,396,900.00 will be made to the Himachal Pradesh Public Works Department (HPPWD) for the timely completion of the library building. The library will serve as a central hub of knowledge and learning for students and faculty.

**B. Renovations/Upgradations:** To enhance the existing infrastructure, several renovations and upgradations have been planned:

1. **Painting, Distempering, and Finishing Work in College Building:** ₹378,404.00 will be paid to HPPWD as the balance payment for the already completed painting, distempering, and finishing work in the college building.
2. **CCTV Cameras Installation and Repair/Replacement:** CCTV cameras will be installed throughout the college premises to ensure safety and security. Additionally, any existing cameras that are out of order will be repaired or replaced. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹500,000.00.
3. **Procurement and Repair of Furniture:** New furniture will be procured for the additional facilities in the new library building. Furthermore, the old damaged furniture will be repaired to extend its usable life. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹500,000.00.
4. **Up gradation of Girls and Boys Common Rooms:** The girls' and boys' common rooms will be upgraded to provide better amenities and facilities for students. This includes the refurbishment of existing spaces, the addition of comfortable seating arrangements, and the provision of recreational and study areas. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹300,000.00.
5. **Classroom Upgradations and Repairs:** To improve the learning environment, classrooms will undergo upgradations and necessary repairs. This includes the installation of modern teaching aids, improved lighting and ventilation systems, and the repair of damaged infrastructure. The estimated



expenditure for this project is ₹1,000,000.00.

**C. New Equipment:** To enhance the college's academic resources, the following projects involving the procurement of new equipment are planned:

1. **Procurement of New Books for the Library:** To keep the library up to date and provide students with relevant resources, new books will be procured. This will ensure a diverse collection of books covering various subjects and disciplines. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹500,000.00.
2. **Establishment of English Language Lab:** An English language lab will be established to improve students' language skills and proficiency. The lab will be equipped with language learning software, audiovisual aids, and interactive materials to facilitate effective language learning. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹500,000.00.
3. **Purchase of Equipment for Science, Geography, and Music Laboratories:** To enhance practical learning experiences, new equipment will be purchased for the science, geography, and music laboratories. This will provide students with hands-on opportunities to explore and experiment in these disciplines. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹900,000.00.
4. **Addition of Workstations in the Central IT Lab:** To cater to the growing demand for computer-based learning, additional workstations will be added to the central IT lab. This will accommodate more students and enable them to acquire essential IT skills. The estimated expenditure for this project is ₹1,000,000.00.

The agenda of meeting was to foster strong collaboration between GC Bhoranj and the Sr. Sec. School(s) of the area.


It was an effort to increase the enrolment and awareness about the future prospects in higher education.

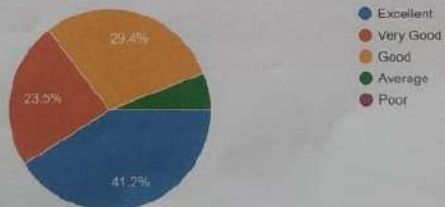
1. How would you rate the curriculum prescribed for your degree during your term in the college?
